

Y-mAbs Connect Patient Assistance Program (PAP) Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for PAP for a Y-mAbs product, a patient must meet all of the following criteria:

- Patient must be enrolled in Y-mAbs Connect
- Patient has been prescribed Y-mAbs product for an FDA-approved indication
 - The prescriber is located in the United States or a U.S. Territory and must certify that based on his/her independent medical judgment, the product is medically appropriate for the patient
- Patient is uninsured or underinsured
 - A patient is considered underinsured when a patient:
 - Has commercial medical insurance, and
 - A prior authorization (PA) for a Y-mAbs product was submitted and denied, and all additional appeal(s) have been exhausted*
- Patient resides in the United States or U.S. Territory
- Patient has an annual household gross income (before taxes and deductions) of less than or equal to 600 percent of the Federal Poverty Level based on household size

*The accurate completion of reimbursement or coverage-related documentation is the responsibility of the healthcare provider and patient/caregiver.

Alternative Assistance Evaluation

Before enrolling a patient in the PAP, Y-mAbs Connect will inquire whether the patient has sought alternate sources of assistance. If the patient has not sought alternate assistance, Y-mAbs Connect will provide the patient with appropriate information to allow the patient to pursue such alternate sources of assistance. However, if the patient indicates that alternate assistance has been sought and is not available, Y-mAbs Connect will proceed with assessing the patient's eligibility for PAP.
